

#### 3. Dear Students, Faculty, and Staff:



### How to use pathos?

 Consider the audiences feelings without forgetting that academic writing requires dispassionate, thoughtful reasoning supported by proof where possible.








## The Rhetorical Triangle



### What is Ethos?



- From the Greek, "Character"
- Writer's "ethical appeal"
- How well the writer presents
- believe people whom we respect.

### **Defining Ethos**

- Refers to the trustworthiness or credibility of the writer or speaker.
- Ethos is often conveyed through tone and style of the message and through the way the writer or speaker refers to differing views.
- It can also be affected by the writer's reputation as it exists independently from the message--his or her expertise in the field, his or her previous record or integrity, and so forth.


